Currently, she holds a position of advisor to the House of Commons Work and Pensions Committee, and a position of special advisor to the Housing, Communities and Local Government Select Committee.

In 1991, she was awarded the Order of the British Empire (OBE) for her outstanding contributions to the field of housing.
